**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Merit Scholarship is issued to the Meritorious students of Arts and Science Programmes, studying in UG/PG Programmes in Government and Government aided Colleges affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli, MSU Colleges, and University Departments are eligible to apply for the Merit Scholarship.
2. Other Scholarship Recipients are also eligible to apply for Merit Scholarship.
3. The Candidates shall have a minimum of 75% attendance.
4. There shall not be any disciplinary Proceeding against the candidate.
5. The Candidates shall have passed their examination in the first appearance.
6. The overall percentage of the candidates shall be for Arts 50% for science 55%
7. There is no Renewal of Merit Scholarship.
8. Students pursuing in Self-Financing Programmes are not eligible to apply.
9. Candidates with break of Study or reappearance are not eligible to apply.
10. Three Candidates from I, II and III year for each UG Programme and Two candidates from I & II year for each PG Programme for affiliated colleges and one candidate from I & II year for each Programme in University Departments and I, II and III year for each programmes in MSU Colleges shall be awarded.
11. Merit Scholarship for UG candidates is Rs.2500/- per student and for PG Candidates is Rs.3000/- per student.
12. The application should be forwarded by the Principal of the College / HoD of the University Departments.
13. The photocopies of Mark Statements should be attested by the Principal / HoD of the University Departments.
14. **a) For I year PG Programme:**  
Selection of the candidates shall be based on the percentage of marks scored in Part III of UG Programme.
- b) For II year PG Programme:**  
Selection of the candidates shall be based on the percentage of marks scored in Part III at First and Second Semesters of PG Programme.
- c) For I year UG Programme:**  
Selection of the candidates shall be based on the overall / academic performance in +2.
- d) For II year UG Programme:**  
Selection of the candidates shall be based on the percentage of marks scored by the candidates in Part III at I & II Semesters for second year candidates.
- e) For III year UG Programme:**  
Selection of the candidates shall be based on the percentage of marks scored by the candidates in Part III at I to IV Semesters for Third year candidates.
