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<u>1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY</u>

INTRODUCTION

Manonmaniam Sundaranar University was established in the year 1990 as per the Tamil Nadu Act 31 of 1990 by the Government of Tamil Nadu as a teaching-cum-affiliating University. The University is named after the Tamil Poet literateur Professor P Sundaram Pillai (1855-1897), the author of the famous verse drama 'Manonmaniam', who was one of the most distinguished men of Tamil letters during the half of the 19th century. This drama also includes the *Tamizh thai Vazhthu* used as the invocation song in all official functions in Tamil Nadu.

Manonmaniam Sundaranar University is situated at Tirunelveli which is in the southern most tip of the Indian peninsula. It covers three districts, namely Tirunelveli, Tuticorin & Kanyakumari. Tirunelveli is famous for its freedom fighters starting from *Veerapandiya Kattabomman*, the great Tamil Poet *Mahakavi Subramania Bharathiar*, who was born in *Ettayapuram* in the Tuticorin District and Vanchinathan. Another famous freedom fighter *V.O. Chidambaranar* launched *the first indigenous Indian shipping service* between Tuticorin and Colombo with the **Swedeshi Steam Navigation Company**, competing against British ships. Palayamkottai remembered as "Oxford of South India" is on the eastern bank of the Thamirabarani river, while its twin city Tirunelveli is on the western bank.

The motto of the University is "*Knowledge is Power*". This University has started functioning in the year 1990 with 7 departments. Presently, the University has 26 academic departments, with 128 full time faculty members, 1421 students, 35573.49 Sq.mt. floor space and 2 satellite campuses located at Alwarkurichi and Rajakkamangalam.

Curricular

Aspects

The programmes offered in this University at Postgraduate, M.Phil., and PhD (course work) levels, are under Choice Based Credit System. Each program facilitates the concerned students to choose elective/optional courses of their interest.

During the assessment period, curriculum for all the Postgraduate and M.Phil., programs were revised as per the guidelines of UGC and instructions of Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education. The syllabus for each course in each program was framed focusing on employability/entrepreneurship/skill development.

Among all the courses across the programs, 18.35% of them were new courses.

Seventy seven (77, in number) value-added courses were introduced to enable the students for imparting transferable knowledge and to develop life skills. Each student were given with an option to gain 8 credits from the value-added courses during their course of study.

The programs offered at Postgraduate and M.Phil., levels facilitated 1259 students (71.05%) to carry out field projects/internships as partial fulfilment of their program.

The University has a structured feedback system to collect feedbacks from students, teachers, alumni, parents and the employers of its alumni periodically. Now, a system has been created in the University to collect feedbacks from the students at the end of each semester rather than at the end of each academic year. The feedbacks were analyzed and the teachers were informed the same to facilitate them for maintaining or to make essential changes in their teaching techniques.

Teaching-learning and Evaluation

Teaching-Learning and Evaluation Process

The University follows the reservation policy of the State Government of Tamil Nadu and 81.65% of the students were admitted against seats reserved for various categories as per the reservation policy. Among all the students admitted, 0.56% of them were differently-abled. The average demand ratio for each program was 132:97.

During the assessment period, new teachers were recruited in the sanctioned vacant positions. Now, there are 86.95% of full-time teachers against sanctioned posts. Among them, 85.95% of them are Ph.D., degree holders. Cumulative teachning experience of all the teachers is 1894 years and the average teaching experience of the teachers is 10.58 years.

The Student – Teacher ratio was 99:10. The University provided Mentor facility to the students and the Mentor- Mentee ratio was 443:30.

The teachers (71.51%) used ICT facilities for delivering their lectures in an effective manner with Learning Management systems, e-learning resources etc. Teachers (7.68%) received awards, recognitions, fellowships at State, National and International levels from Government and other recognized bodies.

The University follows semester system in all its programs offered at Postgraduate and M.Phil., levels. Average number of days from the date of semester-end examination and declaration of results was 39.4 days. The University facilitated the students to address their examination related grievances. At an average 1.79% of complaints were received from students. Among them, 27.6% of the complaints were related to evaluation leading to change in marks. The grievances were redressed as per the regulations.

Research, Innovations and

Extension

The University provided essential facilities to teachers and the research scholars encouraging them to carry out their research in the areas of current interest at global level. Start up research grant of Rs.2.90 lakhs was sanctioned to the young teachers for carrying out Minor Research projects and to use the data to get Major Research Projects.

19 department out of 26, received financial support from UGC, DST, DBT, ICSSR and such other agencies under various schemes. During the assessment period, 105 research projects of the University were funded by government and non-government agencies with grants of Rs.1420.51 lakhs from government sources and Rs 7.0 lakhs from non-governmental sources.

Five teachers received international fellowships for advanced studies and research. There were 221 Full time research scholars (JRF and SRF scholars) in various departments. Ph.D., degrees were awarded to 436 candidates. Teachers published 1591 research papers in peer-reviewed journals at both national and international levels.

Number of citations for research contribution of teachers was 2188 with bibliometric count of 7.14 and 638 works received proportionately maximum number of citations and Rs 76.75 lakhs were brought in for consultancy services. During the period, one patent was awarded, 2 applications were given registration numbers.

The departments conducted 29 collaborative extension and outreach programs and 8.72% of students participated in such programs and 19 rewards were received from various bodies.

University signed 15 MoUs with institutions of national and international importance for various academic related activities.

Infrastructure and Learning Resources

The University has essential infrastructure for conducting its teaching, research and administration related activities. There are104 classrooms and seminar halls in all its three campuses. All the classrooms have ICT facilities for teaching related activities.

The Annual University Budget, sanctioned at an average of 57.54% (excluding the salary component) for infrastructure augmentation. The University had spent a sum of Rs.43.57 lakhs per year for purchase books and journals from the University Budget and the grants received from various funding agencies under different schemes such as UGC-SAP, UGC Infrastructure grant, DST-FIST, NBHM grant for Mathematics, research projects etc.

All the academic departments have computer facilities and Student-Computer ratio is 3:1. The University has provided internet connection with Wi-Fi facility throughout the campus with bandwidth of more than 1 GBPS.

The University has a well-equipped Library, besides the libraries in individual departments. 120 students/ staff visited the University library daily. The Library has provided remote access of digital library to the students, teachers and administrative staff.

The University has access to e-journals, e-ShodhSindhu, e-books and databases.

Some of the teachers developed e-contents for e-PG_Pathshala and SWAYAM. Media Centre, recording facility and lecture capturing system were used for developing e-contents.

Proportion of average annual expenditure of the University, excluding salary component, for maintaining physical and academic support facilities is 63.07%.

Student Support and Progression

The University provided support facilities for the progression of its students. Every year, students received financial support through scholarships and freeships under various Government schemes (78.79%) and non- Government schemes (2.73%).

University provided guidance to students for their preparation to competitive examinations. It also made arrangements for career counseling, soft skill development, remedial coaching, language lab, bridge courses, yoga and meditation, personal counseling schemes for the enhancement of capability of the students. Every year, at an average, 48.21% of students succeeded in the examinations.

University has Placement and Career counselling facilities. An average of 14.48% of outgoing students got placement opportunities during the last five years. The proportion of students pursued higher education was 36.92%.

The institution has a transparent mechanism for timely redressal of students' grievances including sexual harassment and ragging cases.

Students participated in sports and cultural events organized at national and international levels during the last five years. They received 73 awards and medals for their outstanding performance in such activities. The University also organized at an average, 30 sports and cultural events per year. In the annul sports competition, teachers, administrative staff and students were participated and exhibited their sports skills.

In the University, academic departments have separate Alumni Associations and Chapters and 25 meetings were held. Some of the alumni also made contributions for the infrastructure development of their department at a worth of more than 25 lakhs.

Governance, Leadership and Management

The University is governed by Tamil Nadu State Legislate Act (Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Act 1990). As per the Act, His Excellency the Governor of Tamil Nadu is the Chancellor. The University is administered by the Syndicate, chaired by the Vice- Chancellor. Planning Board, Finance Committee, the Standing Committee on Academic Affairs and Senate are the statutory bodies as per its Act.

University took initiatives towards several staff welfare measures including Maternity Leave for Women, preference for admission in the University departments for staff, Subsidized Transport facility, Free Medical facility, Health Insurance, Gymnasium and Annual Tour for women employees.

University provided financial support to the teachers for attending conferences and workshops and 34.72% of the teachers availed this support.

University organized 63 professional development and administrative training programs for teaching and non-teaching staff.

At an average 71 teachers attended professional development programs every year. Periodic

performance appraisal for teaching and administrative staff members conducted.

University submitted all its expenditures and accounts to Local Fund Audit Department and CAG, Government of India for auditing.

Corpus Fund and Pension Corpus Fund were created.

University took careful quality initiatives with reference to the recommendations and suggestions given by the Peer Team during the second cycle of accreditation.

Institutional Values and Best Practices

The University exercised many best practices during the assessment period for sustenance of its values.

University organized 14 gender equity promotion programs.

Institution showed gender sensitivity in providing facilities such as Safety and Security, Counselling and Common Room.

University met 6% of its annual power requirement by the renewable energy sources.

University has initiated reducing power requirements by installing LED bulbs.

In the Annual Budget of the University every year, 0.15% of total expenditures were on green initiatives and waste management.

University has special resources for differently abled students such as Physical facilities, Ramp/Rails, Braille software/facilities, rest rooms, Scribes for examination, Special skill development.

University took 5 initiatives to address locational advantages and disadvantages during the last five years.

University took 11 initiatives to engage with and contribute to the development of local community during the last five years.

University conducted 36 activities for promotion of universal values, national values, human values, national integration, communal harmony and social cohesion as well as for observance of fundamental duties during the last five years.

In the year 2017, the best women achiever award was instituted for the women faculty members in order to encourage academic and co-curricular activities in this regard.
