1. Are the programmes offered under Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDE) in online mode approved by UGC?

ODL Programmes offered under Centre for Distance and Online Education are recognized by UGC-DEB.

Online Programmes offered under Centre for Distance and Online Education are entitled by UGC-DEB.

2. How to apply?
