

Student Feedback on Institutional Governance / Faculty performance

Nature and Extent of Involvement of Faculty and Students in Academic Affairs/ Improvements

The faculty members are actively involved in the conceptualization of emerging areas in Management through their interactions in various academic forums and bring their rich experience into the classrooms for active discussions with the students in the form of Case Discussions and such others.

This is reflected in the framing of the syllabus for the MBA program. This is evident from the **20** Core Courses, **two** MOOCs, **two** Value Added Courses, throughout the MBA program and **one** Summer Internship and **one** Main Project, **58** different electives offered in **seven** specializations namely, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Human Resource Management, Marketing, Production, Logistics and Systems Management, in the third and fourth semesters of the MBA program.

The Board of Studies consists of all the faculty members of the department, Academic Experts from various other Universities, Industrialists, Meritorious Student of the Department (Final Year Student) and a successful Alumnus.

The students are encouraged to give feedback about the academic input they received after they are placed in the corporate and express their views on the gaps, if any, between theory and practice.

Hence, the curriculum of the MBA program offered by the Department of Management Studies, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University is up to date and meets the expectation of the industry and also make the outgoing students as successful Entrepreneurs.

Mechanism / Norms and Procedure for democratic / good Governance

Criteria and Weightage for Admission

A candidate shall be eligible for admission to Master of Business Administration (MBA) course if he/she has obtained Bachelor's degree at least through 10 + 2 + 3 stream, recognized by our University with a minimum of fifty percent (50%) marks in Major and Allied Courses. For SC / ST candidates a Pass is enough through the same stream of education as mentioned above.
